The **6th German federal election** occurred on 14 September 1930 during the Weimar Republic. The number of seats increased from the last election in 1928 (491) to 577 seats, however, the SPD, who remained the largest party saw their share decrease. The Nazi Party on the other hand increased their seats from 12 to 107.

The **German parliamentary election of July 1932**, held after the premature dissolution of the Reichstag, saw great gains by the Nazi Party, which for the first time became the largest party in parliament, though without winning a majority. Together with the Communists, antidemocratic parties commanded a firm majority, making parliamentary governments impossible.
