## Speech and Presentation Rubric

## TARGET Story Student addressed main thought questions Student discussed her or his progress over time, and presents audience with a resolution for the story Had a one sentence summary (thesis) at beginning of presentation and at beginning of each artifact discussion Not just a list of details Audience learned something new about student or about content Content Student made use of examples to illustrate key points Audience learned something about the topic or about student Artifacts were discussed in relation to the thought questions Specific aspects of the artifacts were discussed Student can explained what she or he learned Communication Student enunciates clearly Voice is at appropriate level (projection) Good pacing of speech Use of pauses to highlight important points Professional language: No "ums" and "likes" Student remained composed (no fidgeting, playing with hair, etc) Student was dynamic Movement was purposeful (use of hand gestures, etc) Student looked at audience, not at the board/screen/notes (a glance now and then is ok) Student responded appropriately to questions **Aesthetics** Staved within 6-8 minute time limit Seemed rehearsed and prepared Audiovisuals well formatted, were pre-loaded to avoid wait time Slides had limited text, good use of color Student was "personable"
